

Young choreographers awarded

The "Prix Jardin d'Europe," which is presented to young choreographers as part of the iDANS Festival, was given to winners at the closing ceremony of the festival Sunday.

The Prix Jardin d'Europe is the main project of the Jardin d'Europe, a network supported by the Culture Program of the European Commission and developed by its 10 European partners.

This year the Prix Jardin d'Europe was awarded to the performance E.I.O. by Maria Baroncea, Eduard

Gabia and Dragana Bulut. The value of the award is 10,000 euros and will be used to fund new creations.

Two of the residencies offered by the Jardin d'Europe network were

awarded to Fabian Barba for his show "A Mary Wigman Dance Evening," and the other to the Hungarian-Italian group the "Bloom! Collective" for the show "City." Each residency con-

sists of a two-week workshop at the Workshop Foundation in Budapest.

The Prix Jardin d'Europe is awarded to a dance production presented in the frame of an Emerging Works Summit. Every year, one of the co-organizers stages a festival presenting 10 to 14 works of emerging choreographers selected from both the European dance market and from works co-produced by Jardin d'Europe.

Organized by Bimeras Cultural Foundation, the 4th edition of iDANS took place throughout October in Istanbul around the theme of "Cosmopolitanism."
