



iKEDİ focuses on animals of İstanbul

THE iKEDİ (or iCAT), social creativity project with the slogan "We are Istanbulites", is taking place in the city until October 7. South African puppet creator Roger Titley and Austrian theatre director Airan Berg created iKEDİ.

iKEDİ, organised under the auspices of the iDANS Contemporary Dance and Performance event, particularly focuses on the animals of İstanbul.

As part of iKEDİ, Istanbulites are invited to participate in outdoor puppetry workshops on weekends. The workshops are free and open to people ages 10 and up. Large and small scale puppets of İstanbul's street animals will be on display for the local residents of various neighbourhoods. After the workshops participants may take their iKEDİ animal home to remember their day.

iKEDİ will take place on Saturday, September 8 at Dolapdere Semt Konağı; Sunday, September 9 in Doğancılar Park, Üsküdar; Saturday, September 15 at the Meydan AVM, Ümraniye; Sunday, September 16 at Esenler Park; and Saturday, September 22 at Ortaköy Square.
